Navigating the Skies and Isles of the Fallen Twins



Sailors measured the height of the stars in the sky to track their progress. The same happens on the Seorsus and sky isles.

Sailors also used their knowledge of the constellations to navigate. Because constellations change seasonally, mariners had to know which constellations were visible in the sky at different times of the year in each hemisphere.

On Seorsus, navigators also need to know which sky isle they were closest to when they took their readings using a sextant, sea astrolabe, and mariner's compass.
